# PURCHASE A THEME TEMPLATE.

Sites like Theme Forest sell starter WordPress templates for around \$30. Simply install the theme on your site and customize it to your brand. Easy peasy!



# USE FREE WEBSITE BUILDERS.

GoDaddy and Wix.com sites may be free, but they appear as extremely unprofessional and do not portray your business or brand in a good light.



### HIRE A DEVELOPER ON FIVERR. COM.

This is an inexpensive option for getting a custom site created. It won't be the prettiest or highest-converting website out there, but it's a start.



### EXPECT MIRACLES.

When you go cheap, expect cheap results. If you're not paying high dollar for a true branding and conversion expert, you can't expect your website to do much for you.
